

OHS&R POLICY STATEMENT

Highgate Management is committed to the protection of its employees, its property, and other people from accidental injury or damage from work carried out by and on behalf of the company.

Highgate Management requires high standards of health, safety and welfare as a fundamental business objective. To meet this objective the company will comply with all legislative requirements and take all practicable steps to ensure that it:

- ✓ provides a safe place of work, safe equipment and proper materials;
- ✓ establishes safe work methods and insists that these are practiced at all times;
- ✓ provides training and supervision;
- ensures employees and other persons understand and accept their responsibility to promote a safe and healthy place of work.
